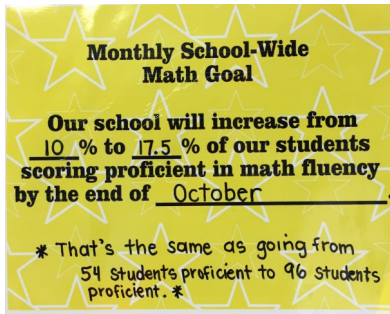
# Forts Pond Elementary A Leader in Me School
